The Ridley Island Energy Export Facility (REEF) is a critical multi-phase project that will connect Canadian liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) to global markets. Located on Ridley Island, near Prince Rupert, B.C., the project is the culmination of years of collaboration with Indigenous and local communities, as well as federal and provincial regulators. Complementing RIPET's foundational export impact, REEF will further establish Canada as a key energy trading partner on the global stage.







TOTAL MARINE CARGOES IN 2025


